

Demolition of Old Water Treatment Plant & New Community Park

If you have driven down Lakeside Drive in the past month you will notice that the view of the Construction Site at the North Bay Water Filtration Plant has changed. Now that the new Plant is online and delivering water to the North Bay residents the old Plant is being demolished.



Demolition of the old Chemical Building and Pumping Station began early June and is scheduled for completion mid July. What will be put in its place once the buildings are removed? The original landscape design called for the relocation of the Tot Park as well as a large area for future storage buildings. After reviewing the area again it was deemed that an expanded neighbourhood park would be a much more appropriate use for this beautiful water front property.



A new community park concept has been developed which includes a Tot Park area and swings both on rubberized surfaces. There will also be an interlocking stone walking path and planting of several new trees, including Cedar, Maple, Hemlock and Crab Apple. The City hopes this new park will be a welcome gift to the surrounding neighbourhood which endured 4 years of construction activity. We all look forward to enjoying the new park area which should be completed late this summer.
